- Gen 37:35 • All his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him, but he refused to be comforted and said, “No, • I shall go down to Sheol to my son, mourning.” Thus his father wept for him.
- Gen 42:38 But he said, “My son shall not go down with you, for his brother is dead, and he is the only one left. • If harm should happen to him on the journey that you are to make, • you would bring down • my gray hairs with sorrow to Sheol.”
- Gen 44:29 If you take • this one also from • me, and harm happens to him, • you will bring down • my gray hairs in evil to Sheol.’
- Gen 44:31 • • as soon as he sees that the boy is not with us, • he will die, and your servants will bring down • the gray hairs of your servant our father with sorrow to Sheol.
- Num 16:30 But if the Lord creates something new, and the ground opens • its mouth and swallows • them up • with • all that belongs to them, and they go down alive into Sheol, then you shall know that • these • men have despised • the Lord.”
- Num 16:33 So they and all that belonged to them went down alive into Sheol, and the earth closed over them, and they perished from the midst of the assembly.
- Deut 32:22 For a fire is kindled by my anger, and it burns to the depths of Sheol, • devours the earth and its increase, and sets on fire the foundations of the mountains.
- 1 Sam 2:6 The Lord kills and brings to life; he brings down to Sheol and raises up.
- 2 Sam 22:6 the cords of Sheol entangled me; the snares of death confronted me.
- 1 Kings 2:6 Act therefore according to your wisdom, but do not let his gray head go down to Sheol in peace.
- 1 Kings 2:9 Now therefore do not hold him guiltless, for you are a wise man. • You will know • what you ought to do to him, and you shall bring • his gray head down with blood to Sheol.”

- Job 7:9 As the cloud fades and vanishes, so he who goes down to Sheol does not come up;
- Job 11:8 It is higher than heaven— what can you do? Deeper than Sheol— what can you know?
- Job 14:13 Oh that * you would hide me in Sheol, that you would conceal me until your wrath be past, that you would appoint • me a set time, and remember me!
- Job 17:13 If I hope for Sheol as my house, if I make my bed in • darkness,
Job 17:16 Will it go down to the bars of Sheol? Shall we descend together into the dust” ?
- Job 21:13 They spend their days in • prosperity, and in peace they go down to Sheol.
- Job 24:19 Drought and heat snatch away the snow waters; so does Sheol those who have sinned.
- Job 26:6 Sheol is naked before • God, and Abaddon has * no covering.
- Ps 6:5 For in • death there is no remembrance of you; in Sheol who will give • you praise?
- Ps 9:17 The wicked shall return to Sheol, all the nations that forget God.
- Ps 16:10 For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or • let your holy one • see corruption.
- Ps 18:5 the cords of Sheol entangled me; the snares of death confronted me.
- Ps 30:3 O Lord, you have brought up my soul from Sheol; you restored me to life from among those who go down to the pit.
- Ps 31:17 O Lord, let me not be put to shame, for I call upon you; let the wicked be put to shame; let them go silently to Sheol.
- Ps 49:14 (2) Like • sheep they are appointed for Sheol; Death shall be their shepherd, and the upright shall rule over them in the morning. • Their form shall be • consumed in Sheol, with no place to dwell. *
- Ps 49:15 But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me. Selah
- Ps 55:15 Let death steal over them; let them go down to Sheol alive; for evil is in their dwelling place and in their heart.
- Ps 86:13 For great is your steadfast love toward me; • you have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.
- Ps 88:3 For my soul is full of troubles, and my life draws near to Sheol.
- Ps 89:48 What man can live and never see death? Who can deliver his soul from the power of Sheol? Selah

- Ps 116:3 The snares of death encompassed me; • the pangs of Sheol laid hold on me; I suffered distress and anguish.
- Ps 139:8 If I ascend to heaven, you are there! • If I make my bed in Sheol, • you are there!
- Ps 141:7 As when one plows and breaks up • the earth, so shall our bones be scattered at the mouth of Sheol.
- Prov 1:12 like Sheol let us swallow them alive, and whole, like those who go down to the pit;
- Prov 5:5 Her feet go down to death; her steps follow the path to Sheol;
- Prov 7:27 Her house is the way to Sheol, going down to the chambers of death.
- Prov 9:18 But he does not know that the dead are there, that her guests are in the depths of Sheol.
- Prov 15:11 Sheol and Abaddon lie open before the Lord; how much more * the hearts of the children of man!
- Prov 15:24 The path of life leads upward for the prudent, that he may turn away from Sheol beneath.
- Prov 23:14 If you strike him with the rod, • you will save his soul from Sheol.
- Prov 27:20 Sheol and Abaddon are never satisfied, and never satisfied are the eyes of • man.
- Prov 30:16 Sheol, • the barren womb, the land never satisfied with water, and the fire that never says, “Enough.”
- Eccles 9:10 Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might, for there is no work or thought or knowledge or wisdom in Sheol, to which you are going. •
- Song 8:6 Set me as a • seal upon your heart, as a • seal upon your arm, for love is strong as • death, jealousy is fierce as the grave. Its flashes are flashes of fire, the very flame of the Lord.
- Isa 5:14 Therefore Sheol has enlarged its appetite and opened its mouth beyond * measure, and the nobility of • Jerusalem and her multitude will go down, • her revelers and he who exults in her.
- Isa 7:10-11 • Again the Lord spoke to Ahaz, “ Ask • • a sign of the Lord your God; let it be deep as Sheol or high as heaven.”
- Isa 14:9 Sheol beneath is stirred up • • to meet you when you come; it rouses the shades to greet you, all who were leaders of the earth; it raises from their thrones all who were kings of the nations.

- Isa 14:11 Your pomp is brought down to Sheol, the sound of your harps; maggots are laid as a bed beneath you, and worms are your covers.
- Isa 14:15 But you are brought down to Sheol, to the far reaches of the pit.
- Isa 28:15 Because you have said, "We have made a covenant with death, and with Sheol we have an agreement, when the overwhelming whip passes through it will not come to us, for we have made lies our refuge, and in falsehood we have taken shelter";
- Isa 28:18 Then your covenant with death will be annulled, and your agreement with Sheol will not stand; when the overwhelming scourge passes through, you will be beaten down by it.
- Isa 38:10 I said, In the middle of my days I must depart; I am consigned to the gates of Sheol for the rest of my years.
- Isa 38:18 For Sheol does not thank you; death does not praise you; those who go down to the pit do not hope for your faithfulness.
- Isa 57:9 • You journeyed to the king with oil and multiplied your perfumes; • you sent your envoys far off, * and sent down even to Sheol.
- Ezek 31:15 "Thus says the Lord God: On the day the cedar went down to Sheol I caused mourning; I closed the deep over it, and restrained its rivers, and many waters were stopped. I clothed Lebanon in gloom for it, and all the trees of the field fainted because of it.
- Ezek 31:16 I made the nations quake at the sound of its fall, when I cast it down to Sheol with those who go down to the pit. And all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, were comforted in the world below.
- Ezek 31:17 They also went down to Sheol with it, to those who are slain by the sword; yes, those who were its arm, who lived under its shadow among the nations.
- Ezek 32:21 The mighty chiefs shall speak of them, with their helpers, out of the midst of Sheol: 'They have come down, they lie still, the uncircumcised, slain by the sword.'
- Ezek 32:27 And they do not lie with the mighty, the fallen from among the uncircumcised, who went down to Sheol with their weapons of war, whose swords were laid under their heads, and whose iniquities are upon their bones; for the terror of the mighty men was in the land of the living.
- Hos 13:14 (2) Shall I ransom them from the power of Sheol? Shall I redeem them from Death? O Death, where are your plagues? O Sheol, where is your sting? Compassion is hidden from my eyes.

- Amos 9:2 “If they dig into Sheol, from there shall my hand take them; • if they climb up to • heaven, from there I will bring them down.
- Jonah 2:2 • saying, “I called out to the Lord, out of • my distress, and he answered me; out of the belly of Sheol I cried, and you heard my voice.
- Hab 2:5 • “Moreover, • wine is a traitor, an arrogant man • who is never at rest. • His greed * is as wide as Sheol; • like • death he • has never enough. • He gathers for himself all • nations and collects as his own all • peoples.”
